# NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH - REQUEST FOR VOLUNTEERS TO BE STREET CO-ORDINATORS Grove

Ward Safer Neighbourhood Police Team (SNT) has asked the SGRA to help find volunteers for each street in the SGRA area to act as a street co-ordinators for Neighbourhood Watch (NHW). The aim of NHW is to create a partnership between a local community, the police and the local authority in order to prevent crime and to set up a messaging system whereby residents can quickly receive messages about incidents, potential threats or share concerns with the police. The role of street co-ordinator is not onerous. It essentially involves establishing contact with residents in their street and then, when necessary, acting as a funnel for information up and down the messaging system.

### ST JOHN'S CHURCH REGENERATION

The ecclesiastical permissions for the Regeneration building work have now been granted, and hopefully the local planning permissions will come through soon. The church building committee and the architects will shortly be working on the detailed design plans for tender submissions to be received in a few months' time.

The various fundraising activities this year have raised £7,514 so far (bringing the total to £43,419) and the Book Fair and Blazing Saddles Barn Dance (see details above) will bring in more money. Also, the *Blossom Scheme* now has 49 Patrons who have pledged over £49,000 towards the Regeneration Fund, and the fundraisers target is to have 60 Patrons.
