NEW FLIGHT PATHS OVER KINGSTON? You may or may not have recently received a leaflet through your door about Heathrow's proposed new flight paths. The airport is planning to increase the amount of flights that can land and depart by altering flight patterns and paths. (This is completely separate from the proposed third runway at Heathrow, which will also inevitably increase air traffic across South west London). The proposal includes an increase in number and a lowering of altitude of flights directly over Kingston, including the Spring Grove area.

Heathrow are obliged to consult with the communities that would be affected. The consultation process includes:

1. A leaflet (which has only been patchily delivered)
2. A website www.heathrowconsultation.com which aims to explain their proposals and a survey which asks for a response from local people.
3. An exhibition at Kingston University Penrhyn Rd Campus on **Thursday 14th Feb from 2-8pm**

The closing date for comments from affected communities is 4th March. If you feel strongly about increased flights paths over our community, please respond via the website or by visiting the exhibition.
